the Heaven's Gate cult suicides. The JonBenét Ramsey murder case was reaching its peak when the Heaven's Gate story broke at 8 p.m. EST, March 28, 1997. McKiernan was in Atlanta, Ga. on assignment when he had to fly to California to cover the mass suicide.

"Our job, without sounding too pious, is to tell the truth and to bring home photos that tell the story," he said. "If things didn't go on, we wouldn't be in business."

Sometimes, covering the darker side of humanity gets to his shooters, McKiernan said.

"It's tough when you see the horrible things in the world. The key is to stay objective," he said. "What ends up happening in these photos is usually something went wrong and by us taking these

photos maybe we're bringing about awareness. I think people need to know what happens."

However, it's not all bad news at ZUMA Press.
